

History of the ConvoY Cup

Since 2002, the historic waters of Bedford Basin have been home to events sponsored by the Dartmouth Yacht Club and the ConvoY Cup Foundation. The events are anchored by a 100-mile ocean race from Halifax to Lunenburg. Harbour races, a sailpast of the historic vessel HMCS Sackville and a junior sail regatta, round out the weekend of on-water activities.

Halifax was the departure point for many of the convoys that were the lifeline to Europe during World War II. Risor, Norway shares this history with Halifax as a convoy port. The events associated with the ConvoY Cup Foundation are intended to honour the convoy veterans who risked their lives for the peace we enjoy today.

The races and other events are held in Canada, Norway and international Locations. This year they return to Halifax. The ConvoY Cup Foundation and the host Dartmouth Yacht Club invite sailors and boaters from all over to participate in this event, "Honouring Those Who Served".
