



## Notice of Race

### Wednesday Night Racing

May 20<sup>th</sup> to October 21<sup>st</sup>  
2009



1. **Organizing Authority:** The Dartmouth Yacht Club of Dartmouth, Nova Scotia shall host the event.
2. **Rules:** The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (*RRS*), the prescriptions of the Canadian Yacht Racing Association, the Notice of Race, (except as any of these are altered by these sailing instructions), and by these sailing instructions. The regatta is designated a Category “C” Event with respect to advertising. The Dartmouth Yacht Club Race Committee (RC) and Protest Committee shall have final jurisdiction on all matters.
3. **Eligibility and Entry:** All Skippers and Owners must be a current member of the Dartmouth Yacht Club. Eligible boats must be registered 30 minutes before the warning signal by signing the appropriate class registration sheet. Registration will take place at DYC Clubhouse. The regatta is open to all boats of the A, B, C, and D classes. A minimum of 4 boats will be registered to comprise a class.
4. **Classification:** The following Performance Handicap Racing Fleet classification requirements will apply:

Class	Handicap Range
Non-Spinnaker D	224 and higher
Non-Spinnaker C	223 and lower
Spinnaker B	159 and higher
Spinnaker A	158 and lower

5. **Entry Fees:** There are no fees.
6. **Schedule:** The regatta shall be divided into 3 series called the Spring Series, Summer Series and Fall Series held on Wednesday nights. Registration shall be at the Dartmouth Yacht Club and shall be completed no later than 5:30 p.m. The Spring Series shall be comprised of 7 races for each class to be held from May 20<sup>th</sup> to July 8<sup>th</sup> . The Summer Series shall be comprised of 7 races for each class to be held from July 15<sup>th</sup> to August 26<sup>th</sup> . The Fall Series shall be comprised of 7 races for each class held from September 2<sup>nd</sup> to October 14<sup>th</sup> .
7. **Courses:** All classes shall sail courses within Bedford Basin.
8. **Scoring:** The scoring system is as follows: Low point system with two drops in each of the Spring, Summer, and Fall Series.
9. **Prices:** Prizes will be awarded at the end of each series.
10. **Insurance:** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$1,000,000.00 per event, or the equivalent.
