

Notice of Race

Sail and Motor Yacht Regatta

August 22, 2009

1. Management: Races will be hosted by the Dartmouth Yacht Club of Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

2. Races: Sailing Yacht Races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS), the prescriptions of the Canadian Yacht Racing Association, the Notice of Race, and where modified, by the sailing instructions. The regatta is designated a Category “C” Event.

Motor Yacht Races will be run as ‘predicted log’ and staggered start competitions, as governed by the DYC predicted log rules, any other applicable rules and this Notice of Race, all as modified by the Sailing Instructions. The advertising category is C.

Dartmouth Yacht Club Race Committee and Protest Committee shall have final authority on all matters.

3. Eligibility: The owner must be a current member of their national governing body, i.e.: local sailors must be a member of the Canadian Yachting Association. Your CYA card or similar proof of membership may be requested at registration. Yachts must have a valid NSYA PHRF rating.

3.1 Registration: Eligible boats must be registered 60 minutes before the warning signal by signing the appropriate class registration sheet. Registration will take place at the Dartmouth Yacht Club clubhouse.

4. Classes: A Class Spinnaker, B Class Spinnaker, Non-spinnaker (Cruiser Class). A minimum of four boats must be registered in order to comprise a class.

5. Schedule: Racing will be held on Saturday, August 22, 2009 and will have the following schedule:

Friday, August 21, 2009

1800-2000 hours: Registration

Saturday, August 22, 2009

1000-1200 hours: Registration

1200 hours: Skipper's Meeting

1200: First gun

6. Entry Fees: \$20.00 registration fee per Boat plus a Donation written on an official pledge sheet which include a legible name and address and are in the amount of \$30.00 or more will automatically receive a tax receipt from the Canadian Cancer Society – Nova Scotia Division by mail. Please Note: Self donation (donation's made on one's own pledge sheet) will not receive a tax receipt.

7. Courses: Racing will take place within Bedford Basin. Courses will be neither windward-leeward nor modified Olympic triangles. Courses will be displayed on the RC boat prior to the start for each class.

8. Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers in each class following the Race.

9. Entertainment: Food, drink and music will be available at registration on August 21st and after the event with live music to follow the prize presentation.

10. Insurance: All yachts must show proof of \$1,000,000.00 liability insurance.

11. Advertising: Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
